**A RESOLUTION AWARDING REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL NO. 09 2022-2023 FOR COUNTY-WIDE
CARE AND MAINTENANCE OF SICK AND INDIGENT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2023-2024**

WHEREAS, Lea County solicited qualifications-based proposals to provide various community services through a competitive contract award process; *and*

WHEREAS, proposed services shall qualify as care and maintenance of the sick and indigent; *and*

WHEREAS, numerous proposals were received by the County of Lea for the provision of such goods and services; *and*

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Lea County has received the evaluations of these proposals and has itself had the opportunity to review all proposals.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Lea County that the following funds be allocated for the named entities:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Manager may negotiate the terms of each contract ensuring that the goods and services received constitute fair market value for the approved funding.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Manager is authorized to finalize and execute each contract on behalf of the County of Lea.
