**A RESOLUTION APPROVING MULTIPLE SERVICES AND ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES
AGREEMENTS BETWEEN LEA COUNTY AND COUNTY MUNICIPALITIES**

WHEREAS, Lea County (County) and the incorporated municipalities of Eunice, Hobbs, Jal, Lovington, and Tatum (Municipalities) have for a number of years entered in Multiple Service Agreements (MSA) and Environmental Service Agreements (ESA); *and*

WHEREAS, in these MSA's the Municipalities have agreed to provide residents of Lea County firefighting services within the Fire District or as otherwise agreed, ambulance services within its EMS District or as otherwise agreed, public library services, senior citizen services, and other services provided by the Municipalities for its residents; *and*

WHEREAS, the City of Hobbs has also agreed to provide permitting, inspecting, and certifying for occupancy any new structures constructed with the Extra Territorial Area; *and*

WHEREAS, the Municipalities have agreed to make convenience center services available to all residents of Lea County (Lovington excluded); *and*

WHEREAS, Lea County has agreed in these MSA and ESA agreements to pay each Municipality for providing the above services to the residents of Lea County.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Lea County that County staff may negotiate an MSA and an ESA agreement between Lea County and the respective Municipality to provide the above services and others at a cost not to exceed the amounts listed in the table below for fiscal year 2023-2024:

Municipality	Multiple Services Agreement	Environmental Services Agreement
City of Eunice	\$ 125,000	\$ 72,000
City of Hobbs	\$ 625,000	
City of Jal	\$ 112,500	\$ 72,000
City of Lovington	\$ 300,000	
Town of Tatum	\$ 87,500	\$ 72,000

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Commission Chair and/or County Manager may finalize and sign any agreements consistent with the terms of this resolution.

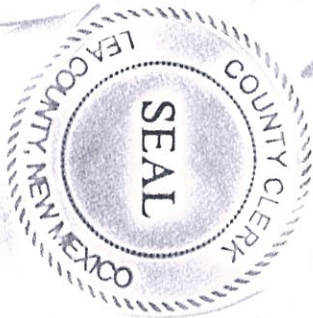
