Bar Back Job Description



Greeley Stampede Bar Backs are beverage employees who support the Stampede Bartenders, Bar Leads, and Bar Managers. Their role is to ensure that bartenders have all the necessary tools and items they need during beverage service hours to keep everything running smoothly and efficiently.

Bar Back Responsibilities:

- Support and assist all fellow bar staff by pouring draft beer, stocking canned items, stocking liquor, stocking nonalcoholic products, and more
- Help provide quick and efficient service to customers
- Clean and maintain the bar area
- Change beer kegs and CO2 tanks when necessary
- Refill Ice bins when necessary
- Ensure that product is chilled and ready for purchase
- Restock bar stations for bartenders; garnishes, cups, ice, additional mixing product, etc.
- Empty draft overflow/dump buckets
- Maintain trash overflow during beverage service hours
- Provide excellent customer service to all patrons
- Adhere to all food safety and quality regulations for food and beverages
- Follow all policies and procedures set forth by the Greeley Stampede
- Handle, use, and clean beverage equipment in appropriate and safe manner
- Other duties as needed

Requirements and Qualifications:

- Must be at least 18 years of age
- Must act and appear professional at all times
- Availability to work nights, weekends, and holidays during the event
- Basic knowledge about menu items
- Exceptional communication skills
- Strong task and time management skills
- Team oriented, reliable, and trustworthy
- Ability to work quickly and accurately in a fast-paced environment
- Ability to maintain a positive, fun, and friendly attitude
- Ability to stand, walk, bend, etc. for extended periods of time
- Ability to lift and move up to 30 lbs. (Occasional heavy lifting over 30 lbs. may be necessary for this position)

Work Schedule:

- Bar Back shifts will be during peak hours of the event. Hours may not be fixed; shifts will range from daily setup time through "volume," meaning that once the bar begins to slow down, bar backs may be phased out.
 - Average weekend shifts are 6pm until approximately 12am on Concert nights and popular rodeo nights
- Applicants must be available to work a minimum of six (6) shifts
- Bar backs will be hourly, non-exempt employees. This position requires flexible scheduling to accommodate peak times, community involvement, and meetings.
