Youth Market, Breeding, Dairy and Exhibition Classes

- By registering for the North Idaho State Fair Youth Stock Show and Sale, you confirm you have read, understand, and agree to the rules and regulations of the program, the North Idaho State Fair, and any additional documents and references necessary for registering, showing, and/or selling.
- Market animals must be registered prior to their initial weigh-in. Meat rabbits are required to register by June 23rd at midnight to show. All entries must be registered and paid for by August 1 at 12 PM, online at nifr.fairwire.com or by form in the fair office. Late registration is available for **Independent exhibitors only** until August 8 at 12 PM by form in the Fair office.

- All exhibitors are required to complete the YQCA training or have the 'test out' certification by time of entry on ShoWorks.
- For information and updates, check the website nisfair.fun and the "NISF Youth Stock Show and Sale" Facebook page.
- Independent Exhibitor Reports are due by 4 PM Wednesday, September 3, 2025 in the Fair Office.
- Every exhibitor will need to submit a completed and signed Animal Affidavit Form with a Husbandry Form completed for each market animal before crossing the scale.

Large market animals over the cap sale weight at final weigh-in will be sold at the cap sale weight. Exhibitors will be paid only for the cap sale weight and buyers will be charged for only the cap weight. Small market animals (rabbits and poultry) exceeding the cap sale weight are ineligible to sell through the NISF Youth Stock Sale.

Min Final Weight = Minimum market animal weight required to show in quality and be sale eligible

CAP Sale Weight = Any animal above this weight will sell at the CAP weight

Minimum ADG = Minimum ADG required to compete in quality judging championships (final drive)

All market steers should be accompanied at final weigh-in by their blue slip for brand inspection. All cattle shows are in the Beef Ring.

Poultry showmanship will include all Market, Breeding, and Exhibition poultry participants. The highest placing market poultry exhibitor in each age division will compete for one spot in the Market Round Robin. The highest placing exhibition exhibitor in each age division will compete for one spot in the Non-Market Round Robin.

Market birds are not required to be used in showmanship. If you only enter a Market bird into the Fair, you may bring in an alternate bird to use for showmanship.

If you are only showing an Exhibition Poultry, **you are still required to show showmanship.**
