## Guidelines:

- 1. All art exhibits in Fine Arts Classes, both Adults and Youth <u>must be framed and wired for hanging</u>, except Youth Division Category A (Pre-K 2nd Grade) which must be matted. All others, Adult and Youth must be framed. <u>Metal saw tooth hangers are not acceptable</u>. No pictures unsuitably framed will <u>be accepted</u>. Pictures must be dry and not previously exhibited in The Nashville Fair. Gallery wrap accepted if properly executed and wired for hanging. No plastic frames, please.
- 2. Numbered Paintings are not acceptable.
- 3. Nothing larger than 48 inches in length or height will be accepted. This includes the frame.
- 4. No Painting on wood or photographs will be accepted.
- 5. Scrapbook layout entries must be in a protective plastic cover and mounted on mat board or other material to keep the layout from bending.
- 6. Single page layout may not exceed 12x12 inches, double layout may not exceed 12x24 inches. Greeting card sets should be mounted on 12 x 12 inch sturdy mat board or in a decorative box.
