Llama/Alpaca RULES

To be eligible to participate in the 4-H show, all youth must have completed the following:

- a) All exhibitors must have participate in two (2) Erie County 4-H Llama/. Alpaca educational meetings to be eligible to show at the fair.
- b) All exhibitors must have given a public presentation prior to May 2025.
- c) All animal must have been identified by June 1, 2025, through the submission of a Llama/ Alpaca enrollment form and/or Llama/ Alpaca Lease agreement listing microchip information to the 4-H office.
- d) All exhibitors must participate in a livestock interview in July 2025.
- e) All participants must be 5 years old as of January 1, 2025. Youth 5-7 years old are cloverbuds and must always have an adult side walker.
- f) Breeding animals MUST submit a copy of the registration form to the 4-H office by June 1, 2025.
- g) Exhibitors shall be neat and clean wearing dress shirt and dark pants or skirt, closed toe shoes.

Health Requirements

- a) All Llama and Alpaca health records must accompany animals to the Fair. All llamas/ alpacas must show proof of active immunization against rabies, and must be negative to an approved test appropriate to detect Bovine Viral Diarrhea persistent infection (BVD_PI).
- b) Llamas and Alpaca must be identified by a microchip that is to be used as positive identification on the official entry form and health papers.

ALL exhibitors are responsible for maintaining their exhibit until released by the 4-H program on Sunday, August 17, 2025, failure to do so will result in not being able to participate at The Erie County Fair in the future and forfeit of premium checks. (See CCE regulations in your handbook)
