The Columbia County Fair Board met in a scheduled session with Butch Guess, Henry Heimuller, Branden Staehely and Mary Ann Guess.

Butch Guess called the meeting to order at 6:27pm

Alice Monroe has some changes to make to the Rodeo Court application and rules. Wants more information on horse requirements, add mailing address, separate rule for the pageant. She will redline the current policy and make changes and additions. We will then send to County Counsel to revise.

Heather Epperly gave out information on the Megga Egg Hunt. It was success. We will post information on our website.

Heather explained she has done a winter event since 2017. It's free to the community and she has used the rec center. She was wondering if she could bring it out to the fairgrounds for one day using the pavilion and having a walk thru display outside the pavilion on the grass. Had discussion on power, CERT would be available. Concerned about parking. Kiwanis was on the calendar and maybe hook up with them. More discussion is necessary.
