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Entries can be placed on-line until July 25th.

Entries are brought to the Farm Pavilion on Monday August 7th from 3 pm to 7 pm. Two late entries will be accepted at drop off.

Entries can be picked up on the Sunday following the Fair from 12 pm to 2 pm in the Farm Pavilion.

*All entries must come with a computer printed 3x5 card with exhibitors name, club, and age for entry to be accepted and judged. Please use a large font size for presentation purposes.

DIVISION A - HOME ENVIRONMENT

Items must be made, assembled, or refinished by exhibitor.

PREMIUMS: Blue \$3.00 Red \$2.50 White \$2.00

CLASS NUMBER

1. Framed picture with a mat and hanger. Picture must be for a specific room. Explain the room color scheme or reason for using the picture in this room.
2. An exhibit showing the color scheme of a specific room mounted on cardboard poster. Include fabric swatches, paint chips, wood samples, etc. Describe type of room and why scheme was used - size of room, exposure, etc. Include hanger on poster.
3. Scrapbook with ideas for improving one room in the home. No more than four pictures to show any one improvement as curtains, furniture arrangements, etc. Suitable fabric samples may be included. Explain why decisions were made.
4. Other project not listed in home environment.

PREMIUMS: Blue \$5.00 Red \$4.00 White \$3.00

CLASS NUMBER

5. Drapery panel for a specific room. Information on color scheme. Type of room, exposure, etc.
6. Bedspread, information on color scheme, exposure to room, etc.
7. Floor rug, give color scheme of room and furnishings in room.
8. Lamp with shade for a specific room. Describe spot where it will be used.
9. Refinished or homemade furniture for use in a specific room. Describe where it will be used.
10. Storage improvement - scale drawing with an explanation of why the change was made. Include before and after.

DIVISION B - CHILD CARE

Each entry must have a computer printed 3x5 card with the exhibitor's name and age. Exhibit will not be accepted without the printed card.

PREMIUMS: Blue \$4.00 Red \$3.50 White \$3.00

CLASS NUMBER

1. Kit or play-safe materials, at least 7 articles, 3 of which are homemade. Describe why you chose these items and for what age child the items are for.
2. Child's book with pages made of cloth, made by exhibitor.
3. Kit of 4 books of interest to children (2 to 6). Include why these books were chosen on a 3x5 card.
4. Other - Explain what you entered and why.

DIVISION C – MONEY MANAGEMENT

Each budget entry must include income and expenditures. Limit of one entry per class.

PREMIUMS: Blue \$3.00 Red \$2.50 White \$2.00

CLASS NUMBER

1. Household budget
2. Special event budget
3. College/education budget
4. Other – Explain what you entered and why.

DIVISION D - ROOM DESIGN CHALLENGE

Materials were given out to participants in March. Watch the 4-H Newsletter in February and March for information date for next year. Sponsoring team of Michelle and Janel provided a cardboard box to members to use as their room. 4-H members also received and a piece of furniture which will establish the scale for the room components.

CLASS NUMBER

1. Room Design Challenge

Room design challenge will involve an interview with a “client” where you, the member, will ask some vital questions about design, color, and interest. Points will be awarded for Originality, continuity of design, and the fulfillment of project requirements listed below.

****Miniature Furniture and dollhouse pieces available commercially may not match the scale we are creating for this project. 4-H members will decorate 3 walls, a floor, and a ceiling. Windows and doors may be cut into the rooms as deemed necessary to satisfy their client’s design goals.**

There is a budget limit assigned to this project of \$20. Include an expense list.

The room design must include:

- Worth up to 5 points each for a total of 80 points
 - 4 handmade items (quilts, afghans, blankets, pillows, curtains, etc)
 - 4 repurposed items
 - 4 photographs showing the 4-Her working on the room
 - 4 painted items
- Up to 10 points will be added to that score for originality and creativity
- Up to 10 points will be added for continuity or cohesiveness of design.
- Bonus Points: Represent your client’s hobby-5 points
- Bonus points: Represent your client’s heritage-5 points

If you would like to use battery operated lights for your room, please make the switches and battery packs easily accessible for the judges and those working to display the rooms.

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
