4-H/GRANGE/FFA SWINE RULES

- 1. Arrive/vet check: 7:00 am 10:00 am, In place no later than 10:30 am
- Please read Livestock Guide for general animal rules and requirements.
- 3. Lice dust powder 14 days before Fair.
- 4. Market & Feeder Rules
 - Individual may be shown out of pens as single entry.
 - All breeds competing together.
 - Only hogs entered in CLASS 52-B (Market Hogs) are eligible for the Market Sale and Carcass Awards.
 - Minimum and maximum weight requirements for market animals are subject to change at the discretion of the packer.
- 5. Feeding hours during Fair: 7:00 am and 5:00 pm.
- 6. No feeding after 8:00 am Monday.
- 7. Feeder pans pulled no later than 8:00am and 6:00pm.

DIVISION 52-AFITTING AND SHOWING

The same hog must be shown for the championship round as in the initial fitting and showing round. The top ten exhibitors in each Class will receive a placing ribbon in addition to the Danish placing ribbon.

CLASS 01 - Hog Carcass

Carcasses meeting the following specifications will qualify for Hog of Merit. Premium points: 20

Hog of Merit (230- 310 lbs.) Specifications:

- 1. Adjusted Rib Fat. Fat thickness over the 10th rib, as measured by ultrasound, must be 0.7-1.0", rounded to the nearest one-hundredth.
- 2. Muscling. Carcasses must have a minimum of 5.0 square inches of loin-eye, measured by ultrasound, rounded to the nearest tenth of an inch.
- 3. Average Daily Gain. Minimum of 1.70 pounds per day fed a minimum of 75 days before the show. Placement of carcasses will be made on the basis of an index for cut ability and gain.
