4H REPTILE RULES

- 1. NO VENOMOUS REPTILES
- Please contact the superintendent about cage sizes, outlets and available room before entering.
- Reptiles must be free of external parasites (i.e. ticks, mites, etc.). They must be clean with no open wounds or they will not be allowed.
- Exhibitors will supply their own food and heating devices (lamps, rocks) if required and an escape proof container. Locks required for all snakes.
- All reptiles will be in their cages during the hours that the exhibit is open except to participate in 4-H events, divisions and for exercises that the superintendent has approved.
- 6. Washington State law prohibits ownership or display of indigenous species.
