- 2. Entered items must be set up for judging by 12:30 pm.
- 3. Entered items may be mailed in advance to be received a minimum of 10 days prior to the contest. Insurance is recommended. Please include our shipping form with your mailed entry. Mail to:

- 4. Eastern States Exposition, contest promoters and/or donors are not responsible for late, incomplete, or misdirected entries.
- 5. Entries may be photographed and used by show donors for promotional purposes; the photos become the property of Eastern States Exposition.
- 6. The New England Center is a non-profit building where Agriculture and Education take precedence over sales. No sales are allowed within the building.
- 7. Entered items delivered by hand may be picked up from 6:00 pm to 8:30 pm the day of the contest, except Best of Department items will remain on display for the remainder of the fair and may be picked up on September 30 from 12:00 pm to 7:00 pm or October 1 from 8:00 am to 1:00 pm. Entered items that were mailed in may be returned in the same manner with prepaid postage and insurance provided by the exhibitor.
 - Entries that are not awarded Best of Department are not guaranteed to be displayed due to space constraints.
- 8. Each item entered must fit within a 20" x 20" table space.
- 9. All entered items submitted must have been completed within the last three (3) years and not have been exhibited at The Big E in prior years.
- 10. All entries must be made from clay, an original design, and hand-built by the exhibitor. No team entries.
- 11. An exhibitor may submit a total of up to three (3) entries. All entries must be included on one exhibitor entry form.
- 12. Entries must be submitted with exhibitor's name, address, and phone number.
- 13. An instructor/professional is an individual who grosses more than \$2,000 per year from their craft, whether in sales or teaching.
- 14. With entry submission, you accept all contest rules and agree to be bound by the judges' decisions, which will be final.

The judges' decision will be final. Judging will be based on:

- Quality of work, overall craftsmanship and degree of difficulty
- Design, form, originality, and overall execution of the piece
- Quality of finish and is the finish appropriate for the piece
