Division 603 Wearing Apparel, i.e., sweaters, hats, socks, scarves,

mittens, etc.

Division 604 Home Accessories, i.e., afghans, tablecloths, pillows,

doilies, etc.

Division 605 Toys, i.e., dolls, amigurumi, etc.

Division 606 Mixed Media – any entry that may include beading/knitting/weaving within
