- 1. Please read and abide by all The Erie County Fair and Creative Arts Department rules and regulations.
- 2. **All entries must be registered by Friday, July 11, 2025.** Entries not registered will not be accepted. For more information see the Important Entry Information page at www.ecfair.org.
- 3. All work must have been done by the exhibitor within the last five (5) years.
- 4. Excellent kit work will be accepted; however, preference in judging will be given to creative and original work.
- 5. The quality of the article is the main consideration for judging. All items must be clean, and dust removed.
- 6. More than one (1) 1st Premium (Blue) and 2nd Premium (Red) may be awarded in each class if warranted.
- 7. Should there be no deserving entries in any class, no premium will be awarded.
- 8. NO ENTRY EXCEEDING IN OVERALL SIZE OF 36" x 36" x 36" WILL BE ACCEPTED, unless otherwise specified.
- 9. No plastic canvas (except: Door/Wall Decorations, Class #5; Other Items, Class #4; Arts & Crafts Seniors, Class #1)
- 10. Amateur is defined as a person who engages as a beginner and does for pleasure.
- 11. Professional is defined as an expert or business practice.
