Backyard Chickens Vocabulary



Hen: A female chicken

Pullet:

A young hen that is less than a year old and has not started laying eggs.



Chick: A baby chicken (newly hatched)



Hen and chicks

Crumbles:

Chicken feed

Molting:

Shed feathers that will be replaced by a new growth.

Nesting box:

A box provided for a chicken to make her nest and lay her eggs in a quiet, secure place.

Perch or roost:

A place where chickens settle or congregate to rest at night.

Scratch:

A mixture of ground corn, grain, and millet that is a special treat for chickens.



Different colors of eggs that can be laid by hens. Check the ear color and you can predict the egg color.



Rooster: An adult male chicken
