

Bastille Day Pinwheel

One of the revolutionary days in Paris and now a national holiday, the 14th of July ("Bastille Day") is celebrated with a mixture of solemn military parades and easygoing dancing and fireworks. The storming of the Bastille on July 14, 1789 has been commemorated in France for more than a century and signaled the first victory of the people of Paris against a symbol of the "Ancien Régime" (Old Regime). Use the French colors blue, white, and red to color in the stripes and then follow the picture instructions below. Once folded and pinned, glue to a straw or stick.
