SPECIAL RULES

1. **READ GENERAL RULES.** All entries and awards within this show will be subject to the General Rules and Regulations published in this Premium Book and the following Special Rules.
2. **ELIGIBILITY.** All exhibitors must be a paid member of the Belted Galloway Society, Inc. Animals must be registered in the U.S. Belted Galloway Society, Inc. Herd Book or recorded in the Canadian Belted Galloway Association Herd Book. Purebred Mismarked Cattle will be identified by a mismark code of M1, M2, M3, M4.
3. **PREMIER BREEDER.** Awarded to exhibitor accumulating the most points on animals bred by him/her and shown in the individual classes.

PREMIER EXHIBITOR. Awarded to the exhibitor accumulating the most points on animals (not to exceed 10) exhibited by him/her in individual classes.

POINT TABULATION. The highest amount of points allowed per class will equal one less than the number of animals in the class (10 shown first gets 9 points, 2nd gets 8 etc.)

- a. Class with only one animal will not receive any points.
- b. Points will be given for Divisional Champions & Reserve Champions – equaling the number of classes represented (Cow/Calf and Steer are considered a division) i.e., 3 classes = 3 points for Division

Champion, 2 points for Reserve.

- c. No points for Grand and Reserve Grand Champion Female or Bull or group classes.
- d. Animals owned jointly will be considered a separate exhibitor in Premier Exhibitor tabulations. Leased animals will be considered an entry of the Lessee.
- e. To be eligible for Premier Breeder, the breeder must be an exhibitor in the current show.
- f. In the event of a tie the number of points shall be divided by the number of animals the points were derived from and the exhibitor/breeder having the higher point average shall be presented the award.

4. HERDSMAN. Eastern States Exposition will award a Herdsman's show stick to the Belted Galloway exhibitor showing consideration to fellow exhibitors and Management representing his/her cattle and farm to the public in a positive manner as determined by the Beef Show Superintendent.

5. STEER CLASSES. Steers must have a Society Paper of Recordation. Steers will be divided equally into weight classes after weigh-in. If total animals cannot be divided evenly, the larger class would first be Prospects, then Lightweight, etc. Weigh-in will be available on arrival, following health inspection.

6. Any Heifer with a calf at the side will go into Cow-Calf A.

7. LEASE INFORMATION. To comply with recent action taken by U.S. Belted Galloway Society:

- A lease agreement must be on file with the CLRC by July 1, 2024 for animals to be shown under the lessee's name.

- Exhibitor Points will be awarded to the Lessee of the animal.
- If animal is shown under the lessee one day of a multiple day show, the animal must continue to be exhibited under the lessee for the duration of the entire show. The lease cannot be terminated half way through an event.
- Lease fees are waived for Junior members.

8. TIE OUTS. Show management reserves the right to assign tie-outs prior to arrival.

9. This show will follow the Belted Galloway society sanctioned show rules.

JUNIOR RULES

1. ELIGIBILITY. Belted Galloway Junior Exhibitors must be between 21 years of age and 8 years of age as of January 1, 2024, to actually lead an animal – younger participants will have special arrangements made. Each Junior must be a member of the Beltie Youth Group. Exhibitors may show a bull calf under 8 months in Cow-Calf only. Exhibitors must fill out Junior Beef Show entry form in addition to Open Show form.

2. OWNED AND LEASED ANIMALS. Junior's name must be on the registration as owned or co-owned. Leased animals will be accepted if dated by July 1, 2024. The Junior Show will be a combined Owned and Leased Show. Junior exhibitors may show in the Open Show. An animal entered in a Junior's name and shown in the Junior Show must be shown in that exhibitor's name in the Open Show. A lease constitutes ownership.

3. CATTLE BIRTHDATES. See below. No bulls in the Junior Show.

4. All Junior Exhibitors will step forward during Open Show classes for junior placings to be awarded and received. A Champion Female and Reserve Champion Female owned/shown by a Junior Exhibitor will be awarded. If more than 50 head are entered in the Junior Show a separate event will be held.

5. All Junior exhibitors will abide by regulations as to entry, stabling, health, etc.

6. BRED AND OWNED ANIMALS will be acknowledged by pullout following class placing.

GROUP CLASSES**STEERS ARE ELIGIBLE FOR USE IN GROUP CLASSES.**

- 11065 Get-of-Sire: Three animals, sired by one bull. All animals must have been shown in individual classes to be eligible. Both sexes represented. Does not need to be owned by the same exhibitor.
- 11066 Best Pair of Weanlings: Both sexes represented must be weaned and entered in their own class or cow/calf class. Animals must be owned, co-owned or leased to a Junior by the exhibitor.
- 11067 Best Pair of Yearlings: Both sexes represented must be over one year and entered in their classes. Animals must be owned, co-owned or leased to a Junior by the exhibitor.
- 11068 Produce of Dam: Two head, either sex, from the same dam. ET calves accepted. Do not have to be owned by one exhibitor.
- 11069 Breeder's Herd: 5 head, both sexes represented must be bred and owned by the exhibitor.
- 11070 Best Six Head: Both sexes represented and shown individually in classes above. Animals must be owned, co-owned or leased to a Junior by the exhibitor.

PUREBRED MISMARKEDED BELTED GALLOWAY FEMALES

- 11080 Cow/Calf (classes to be broken upon entries)
Cow must be owned by exhibitor, all calves must be born in '23, calves are eligible for heifer classes. All cows & calves to be shown on a halter.
