Show Guidelines:

The purpose of the Brazos Bill's Champions show is to provide an opportunity for Brazoria County youth with special needs the opportunity to take part in a livestock show. Buddies will assist the Champions (Participants) in the preparation and exhibition of the livestock.

- 1. Champion must be a student in a Brazoria County school.
- 2. Champion must be at least 9 years of age and have not reached their 21st birthday (and in high school) by September 1, current year.*
- 3. Champion cannot already be an exhibitor in any other Jr. Livestock show at the Brazoria County Fair.
- 4. Champion must submit an entry form and Acknowledgement of rules by September 19th, 2025.*
- 5. Thirty (30) Champions will be selected for the Brazos Bill's Champions Show. Those that have not been previous Champions will be selected first then any open spots will be filled with other entrants.
- 6. Champions will receive an email verifying their participation in the Brazos Bill's Champions Show.*
- 7. Champion must be at the event and checked in by 9:45 am. This will allow time for them to be paired with a buddy and get familiar with an animal. Exceptions with extenuating circumstances will be made with prior communications to Fair Office.*
- 8. Parent/Guardian must accompany Champion.
