1. The entries and awards in this department are subject to General Livestock and Fair rules printed in this catalog unless otherwise specified.

2. Heifers entered in all other Junior Heifer Shows may be shown in Junior Breeding Beef with proper entry and entry fee paid for Junior Breeding Beef.

3. THERE ARE NO FAMILY ENTRIES IN THE JUNIOR BREEDING BEEF SHOW.

4. All Breeding Beef animals must be approved by an Agricultural Science Teacher, a 4-H Leader, or a county agent before bringing it to the show.

5. Animals entered in this department must be registered in the records of their respective breed association (in the name of the exhibitor) on or before July 1st of current year.

6. The papers of registered heifer/cows must be sent with entry forms. All other heifers/cows will be shown in the Crossbred breed. No substitution after entry deadline. No substitutions at check-in. Each heifer/cow may only be entered into one (1) breed.*

7. No bulls will be shown in the Junior Breeding Beef Show.

8. Merit must exist to win an award.

9. Showmanship will follow immediately after the selection of the Overall Grand and Reserve Grand female. There will be no sign up. If the exhibitor wishes to participate in showmanship, they will show up at the gate when their age group is called. The age groups are as follows: Junior (8-10), Intermediate (11-13), and Senior (14-19). All exhibitors wishing to participate must be the owner of the calf they are showing, and the calf must be entered in the Breeding Beef Show. Cattle

need not be fitted for the Showmanship Show. Winners will be announced immediately after the contest. See General Livestock Rule # 17.

10. All animals must be stalled using safe cross ties defined as 3/8" or larger durable rope.

11. There will be no sift for the Junior Breeding Beef Show.

12. There will be no fitting, watering, or feeding in the holding area. Only exhibitor and their respective animal will be allowed in holding area.

13. For exhibitor eligibility requirements, see General Livestock Department rules.

14. All exhibitors in the Junior Breeding Beef Show must wear their show numbers pinned to the back of their shirt or blouse.

15. Registration requirements will follow individual breed association rules as posted on the breed website for each respective breed.

16. Fitting requirements will be a blow and go show. Animals are to be shown in their natural confirmation and color. No animal may be shown that has any foreign objects glued to or otherwise attached in a matter so as to alter its confirmation or change its appearance; this includes false hair, artificial color, oil, and/or adhesives. Animals unethically fitted in having modification of dewlap or sheath, injection of oil, air, and/or any other foreign substance that alters its physical appearance or confirmation to any part of the body will be disqualified. This does NOT include dehorning or tail docking.

17. The Junior Breeding Beef Show will consist of the following breeds:

Crossbred, Angus, ARB, Beefmaster, Braford, Grey Brahman, Red Brahman, Brangus, Charolais, Chianina, Hereford, Aberdeen, ORB, Red Brangus, Red Angus, Santa Gertrudis, Shorthorn, Simbrah and Simmental.*
