## **Combine Demolition Derby Rules**

- 1. You may use any year make and model combine harvester older than 1995.
- 2. **Must have a seat and seatbelt securely fastened is factory location.** Must have a chicken wire fence in the driver's window for safety to ensure you won't fall out. Safety will be extremely important if you run a model where your engine is to the side of the cab that window will need to be blocked off with a plate. Any and all mirrors or glass must be removed. Please note each specific part of combine components and follow those rules. Thanks
- 3. **Header** Any head may be used but please keep safety in mind as you follow rules. Header may be no wider then 12ft. No sharp points so front of header may be capped with steel tubing or plates ends of header may also be plated or capped ends must be rounded and not dangerous points. If you use a corn head stouts must be removed if you use a straight head sickle guards and cutter bar must be removed. Max header height is 2ft. You may weld or attach header to feeder house and or front axle in any way that is safe. This header attachment and header reinforcement rules and pretty wide open and unlimited get creative have fun. I've seen 55 gal barrels or other things that you can use to create something unique but these rules will be enforced on a safe to you and others aspect so please be smart, safe and respectful.
- 4. **Auger** Auger must be cut to length of harvester. I don't want them sticking out past in a dangerous way. They must be reinforced to stay on the machine if they do swing out you will be disqualified.
- 5. **Tire** You may run any tire. You are allowed to have a plate or protector over front tires only and this protector may run from header to 8in behind the front wheel. Or be mounted to the front tire rim. Rear tire must be factory sized and location using any rubber tire and wheel.
- 6. **Steering** You may repair steering parts within reason not strengthen beyond factory this is only for repair or make something work. Do not abuse this please and thank you.
- 7. **Components** Any battery or safety things may be moved or modified for safety. We don't want your battery getting hit sparking a fire or blowing up. Any steel side panel may be welded together or welded to the machine using 3in wide by 1/8in thick material. You may add anything to your combine to create a unique design as long as it doesn't add strength or be deemed unsafe.
