

CWSF JUNIOR FAIR SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The CWSF Junior Fair offers a \$300 scholarship for any CWSF Junior Fair participant who plans to enroll at a post-secondary institution. These scholarships can be applied to costs at a technical college or university.

Recipient of the scholarship will be determined by the scholarship committee of the CWSF Junior Fair Board.

SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

1. Students may apply during their senior year of high school.
2. Applicants must have participated in the Central Wisconsin State Fair Junior Fair as an exhibitor for a minimum of two years with one of those years being the year prior to the year they are applying.
3. You must submit this scholarship application with one letter of recommendation from your 4-H Club, FFA Advisor, or other youth organization leader.
4. Scholarship application must be typed using the below form.
5. Do not attach any extra sheets, other than your letter of recommendation. Extra sheets will be disregarded.
6. Winner will be announced at the Central Wisconsin State Fair Junior Fair awards program on Thursday of the fair.
