- 3. You must submit this scholarship application with one letter of recommendation from your 4-H Club, FFA Advisor, or other youth organization leader.
- 4. Scholarship application must be typed using the below form.
- 5. Do not attach any extra sheets, other than your letter of recommendation. Extra sheets will be disregarded.
- 6. Winner will be announced at the Central Wisconsin State Fair Junior Fair awards program on Thursday of the fair.
