Have respect and consideration for others with whom you share the facility.

Please do your part in maintaining the beautiful and well-maintained camping facilities for the future.

- 1. All public laws will be enforced.
- 2. No Fireworks allowed.
- 3. Camping is PRE-PAID. Each camping unit must have a permit and easily visible to Fair Staff.
- 4. RV spaces are allowed one additional tent per campsite.
- 5. Restrooms and showers are available near all camping areas.
- 6. No open flame fires will be allowed. Barbeques, Hibachi's, camp stoves, or similar cooking devices you bring must be keep the fire/charcoal fully contained and at least 18 inches above the ground. Proper Disposal is your responsibility.
- 7. Do your part in keeping restrooms and camping areas clean.
- All camping units are to be parked and left in allocated camping space until the end of your stay. Vehicles are to be disconnected from camping unit, and parked in designated parking areas only.
- 9. No other vehicular traffic is permitted in the campgrounds.
- 10. No ORV's may be ridden/operated on the Fairgrounds.
- 11. Horses may be ridden only in designated areas and are not permitted in the campgrounds.
- 12. Livestock is not permitted in campgrounds.
- 13. All Fairgrounds property is to be left in its place and location. This includes garbage containers and picnic tables. All garbage is to be placed in proper containers. Garbage cans are placed conveniently on the grounds.
- 14. One 110- volt, 30 amp service is provided. Any alteration or damage to county property will result in fines and/ or legal action.
- 15. All guests are responsible and liable for damage in their areas during time of use.
- 16. The Grant County Fairgrounds is not responsible for any loss due to fire, accident, or theft.
- 17. Sewer Hook-ups are available only in prepaid, designated campgrounds with additional fees.

- 18. Dumping of "Black" or "Grey" water-except in approved hookups is **strictly prohibited!**
- 19. Camping check out begins at 5 am the Sunday after fair. No Campers will be permitted to leave sooner unless a camper exception request has been filled out a minimum of 7 days in advance.
- 20. Keep noise at a reasonable level at all times during the Fair, and all activities are to shut down by 10:00pm as the Grant County Fair is designed to be an educational event for our participants.
- 21. Domestic Pets are not permitted on the Grant County Fairgrounds during Fair, except for service animals and/or approved show animals.
- 22. Please do not bother/harass any animals that may be on the grounds for other events.
- 23. Driving is permitted on roadways only. No Non-camping vehicles are allowed to access the campgrounds during Fair.
- 24. Unacceptable behavior will not be tolerated.
- 25. Public consumption of alcohol is **strictly prohibited** on Fairgrounds property except in designated areas.
- 26. Anyone not abiding by these rules or instructions of Fair Staff will be asked to leave the fairgrounds with forfeiture of all fees paid.
- 27. For emergencies of a life threatening nature, call 911. Tell them which campground you are in, (East, North, Pavilion, Centerfield, Rodeo Grounds, or South Field) and spot number if known. Turn on lights of a vehicle to attract the response team.
- 28. If you have a non-life threatening emergency involving the fairgrounds facility (water leak, garbage cans, electrical outage) and need immediate assistance and no staff is on duty at the shop or the office, call 765-3581.
- 29. All activities are governed by the Fair Director or designated representatives.
- **30.** Absolutely No refunds will be given.
