## Palouse Empire Fair Camping Rules

- If you choose not to read the following you are still held liable and responsible for following the rules.
- Move in for Fair Camping will be Tuesday, September 5<sup>th</sup>, Fair Office Opens 8:00am to 6:00pm
- Early Camping is due August 15<sup>th</sup>, or spot will not be reserved. Contact Fair office for reservations.
- All camping is reserved through the Palouse Empire Fair Office – No Subletting of Spaces.
- SUPERINTENDENTS, FAIR BOARD and LARGE ANIMAL EXHIBITORS receive priority in camping reservations.
- Camping Rates: \$75 for RV Lot, \$55 Power Hookup only, \$35 Dry – No Hookups.
- Camping spaces will be confirmed once payment has been received by May 1<sup>st</sup>, if not reserved by due May 1<sup>st</sup>, camping space will be reassigned.
- Camping permits must be displayed and visible to Campground Superintendent on your camping vehicle.
- Camping Packets with camping permits are available in the Fair Office M-F 8:00am -6:00pm
- Excess vehicle must be parked in Fair Parking lot.
- No vehicle movement in any of the campground areas during Fair hours of operation.
- Personal ORV's, ATV's, or Golf Carts must be approved by Palouse Empire Fair Office.
- Campground Gates for vehicles to access will **OPEN** at **9:00 p.m.** and close at **8:00 a.m.**
- Placement of **vehicle over 35' and wider than 13'** are up to the discretion of the Fair Office.
- Tip-outs must fit in within the chalked lines.
- Those Camping in Hugh Huntley and Vendor Areas. May run Air Conditioners powered by generators only.
- Quiet time is 10:00p.m. - 7:00a.m. You may not run generators during these hours.
- Campers must respect the rights of neighboring campers while staying at the Fair. Campers found to be disruptive will be asked to leave the grounds and forfeit the camping fee.
- One small tent maybe set up in conjunction with a reserved camper/RV/trailer space.
- Cancellation Policy – Cancellations must be made by July 1st, for a full refund of the camping fee.
- Exhibitors are asked to leave their pets at home. Dogs, other than a service animal or show animal, are not allowed in the Fair area. All dogs must be kept on a leash or left inside your recreational vehicle. Dogs may not be left tied unsupervised outside in your campsite. Dog droppings must be immediately picked up and disposed of in the proper trash receptacles. Barking, aggressive behavior, or failure to follow rules above are grounds for immediately revoking your use of campgrounds.
- Children must be supervised at all times. Children may not be left unsupervised in any camper/RV/trailer or any campsite. There must be at least one authorized, supervising adult staying with children in your camper/RV/trailer or at your campsite during evening hours and overnight.
- Owners of campers/RVs/trailers/tents visiting the Whitman County / Palouse Empire Fair campsites will hold Whitman County harmless for any damages sustained while being camped. Whitman County is also not responsible for any stolen items from the campsite.
