- Agriculture and Horticulture Display including Canstruction + Giant Vegetable Competition
- Indiana Arts Building Exhibits
- Competitive Events Promotion and Entry
- Shoot and organize photos during the 2025 Indiana State Fair for the Entertainment Department
- Event setup & teardown
- Assist with general Accounting in relation to various for the Entertainment Department: requisitions, purchase orders, invoices, check needs, etc.
- Involved Overall support of the Marketing Department
