



APRIL CROP REPORT

April Status: Oregon Wheat

The 2024 Oregon wheat crop has an excellent start throughout the state. Planted estimates remain relatively flat at roughly 295,000 hectares (versus 299,000 in 2023 and 295,000 in 2022). Fields planted to winter wheat had good snow cover during the colder winter period and the crop has been further bolstered by additional precipitation in March and April. Spring work is underway timely.
