## Crop Quality Report

The finally weekly report from the Wheat Marketing Center is now available. For soft white, the sampling reflects:

- Test weight at 60.9 lb/bu, slightly higher than the 5-year average
- Moisture content at 9.0%, similar to the 5-year average
- Protein content at 9.3%, lower than the 5-year average of 10.3%.
- Average falling number value lower than the 5-year average of 327 seconds.
