

DryTown Park Policies

Guests understand that they are voluntarily participating in hazardous recreational activities and assume any and all risks. DryTown is not responsible for any injuries sustained from use of park facilities.

- DryTown cares about the safety and well-being of its guests. Read and comply with posted signs and instructions given by park staff.
- Please look at the rides and decide for yourself if you can ride. You are the best judge of your limitations. Guests, whose physical or mental limitations could create a hazard for themselves or others, should not ride.
- Failure to follow all rules and instructions can result in serious injury to yourself and others.
- Lifeguards are here to help, but cannot take the place of a Parent or Guardian in supervising or safeguarding your child.
- Ride at your own risk.
- Carry-in food and drinks (excluding water) are not permitted in DryTown.
- No alcohol, smoking, pets, skates, skateboards, scooters, or bicycles.
- Small coolers with water and/or ice only are permitted in DryTown.
- Appropriate attire, behavior, and language are required at all times. Inappropriate or vulgar attire, behavior, and language unsuitable for a family environment will be grounds for refusing admission or removal from the park without a refund.
- Patrons are responsible for their own safety in the park. Rowdy behavior, aggressive horseplay, and non-compliance with rules is grounds for removal from the park without a refund.
- DryTown reserves the right to refuse admission to any guest who appears to be intoxicated or under the influence of controlled substances.
- Children ages 12 and under must be accompanied by an adult (18 or older) at all times.
- Diapered guests must wear reusable plastic diaper covers.
- Weak or non-swimmers should wear a life jacket.
- Only U.S. Coast Guard approved life jackets are permitted in the park.
- Photographers are occasionally employed by the City to take photos for promotional purposes. Entrance grants consent for your photo to be used in promotional materials without compensation.
- The use of recording devices is not permitted in the park.
- Weapons of any kind are not permitted.
- DryTown is not responsible for lost, stolen or damaged items.
- Re-entry is permitted with an admission receipt and a hand stamp.
- California Certificate of Compliance may be viewed at DryTown's Town Hall.
