All entries are due to the Pavilion Annex on Saturday, July 27th, before the Fair, from 10 a.m. to noon or Sunday, July 28th, from 10 a.m. to 7 p.m. All entries and awards will be released on Sunday, August 4th, following closing day of the Fair, between 9:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m.

1. All entries in this department must have been produced by the exhibitor and completed after last year's fair.
2. An exhibitor may enter three items in each class.
3. Quilt dimensions must be displayed on folded quilt prior to entering.
4. All items must be CLEAN AND ODOR FREE.

## Soiled items will not be accepted. The Department Superintendent will have the right to reject such items.

Some things judges consider for quilting:

- Piecing/appliqué' technique
- Borders and sashing
- Quilting design and technique
- Binding or edges
- Corners
- Quilt marking lines


## DIVISIONS:

A. Youth - persons 16 years of age and under
B. Adult - persons 17-61 years of age
C. Seniors - persons 62 year of age and over

## GRAYS HARBOR COUNTY FAIR QUILT BLOCK CONTEST

Theme: A Whale of a Good Time
Colors: Navy, Aqua, Blue, Yellow, Gray

1. Send a self-addressed, stamped envelope to the Grays Harbor County Fair, PO Box 1229, Elma WA 98541 for rules and challenge fabric, or a packet may be picked up at the Fair Office in Elma at 32 Elma McCleary Rd.
2. Create a $12 \frac{1}{2}$ inch block. Do not quilt or finish the edges of your block.
3. Challenge fabric is provided. At least $1 / 3$ of the challenge fabric must be incorporated into your quilt block. You may use other fabrics of your choice. You may embellish as you wish, but please sew your embellishments on.
4. All appliqués with fusible web must be sewn on.
5. Quilt block entries are limited to three (3) quilt blocks per exhibitor.
6. Block contest entries may be dropped off the Fair Office before July 24th, 2024. If mailed to the fair office, it must be received by July 24th, 2024. They may also be brought to the home arts department on entry days.
7. Blocks will be judged by the Fair Sewing \& Quilting Judge for ribbon placements. Merchandise awards will be awarded by numerous merchants. Drawings will be held for the blocks.
8. Please remember to pick up your ribbons and awards following the fair. If not picked up by August 16th, ribbons and awards will be forfeited.
