Before entering, please refer to Entry instructions for Rules and Regulations.

1. Entries to be dropped off Sun., Aug. 18 between 10 a.m.–6 p.m. in Building 3.
2. All exhibits will be released Sun., Aug. 25, from 8 a.m.–10 a.m. Fair personnel and Superintendents are not responsible for items remaining after 10 a.m.
3. Articles must be made by the exhibitor, completed within the year, and not exhibited previously at the Benton Franklin Fair. Articles that are soiled, showing wear, or not deemed worthy will not be judged or exhibited.
4. Class designation may be changed by the superintendent as necessary.
5. Exhibitor has pre-entered in this department and will select the division and class at time of judging. Exhibitor will be required to complete a separate form for each division they enter.
6. Pictures and hanging items must be ready to display. Clothing needs to be hung on a hanger so that it can be easily displayed on the wall or a clothes bar.
7. Each entry is judged on an individual basis and not judged against other entries.
