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Before entering, please refer to Entry instructions for Rules and Regulations.

1. Entries to be dropped off Sun., Aug. 20, between 10 a.m.–6 p.m. in Building 3.
2. All exhibits will be released Sun., Aug. 27, from 8 a.m.–10 a.m. Fair personnel and Superintendents are not responsible for anything left after 10 a.m.
3. LIMIT: **Five entries per class number** except class “Other,” limit 10. NO duplications in any class.
4. Exhibitor needs to pre-enter in this department and will select the division and class at time of registration with an accurate description of each item to be exhibited. Exhibitor will be required to complete a separate form (the departments Itemized Sheet) for each division that they enter during time of check-in.
5. Division and/or Class designation may be changed by the superintendent, as necessary.
6. All pictures, drawings, paintings, etc., must be framed or matted and ready to hang with wire or suitable picture hangers on the back.
7. No sharp objects (barbed wire, knives, etc.)
8. All entries with Lego, K’nex, Lincoln Logs, etc. need to be lightly glued to keep problem pieces in place. Please provide a photo (Can be an 8.5 x 11 photo printed on copy paper) of completed entry in case it comes apart and we need to fix/repair the entered item. We recommend using Beacon’s 3-IN-1 Craft Glue. It comes off easily when you want to disassemble your entry.
9. Articles must be made by the exhibitor, completed within the year, and not exhibited previously at the Benton Franklin Fair. Any entry that is damaged, broken, or showing wear (soiled and/or odor) will not be judged or exhibited.
10. Each entry in Dept. 16 is judged on an individual basis and not judged against other entries.
