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**Before entering**, please refer to General Information Youth (4-H/Grange) & FFA and Rules and Regulations.

### 1. Registration Requirement:

- Exhibitors must register separately for each department regardless of being registered for showing an animal.
- Exhibitors must register each poster separately within their respective divisions. For example, if submitting 3 educational posters, exhibitors need to register 3 entries.
- \* Link for registration\* (had a hand full of people complain that finding the registration links and or info was hard to get to are they located in multiple places?)

### 2. Deadline for Registration & Poster Pick Up:

- All entries must be registered by midnight on 07/26/2024. Late registrations will not be accepted.
- Posters will be available for pick up on 08/16/2024 - 08/17/2024 from 10 am -6 pm in the 4-H building.
- The person picking up the posters will be required to sign posters and ribbons.

### 3. Judging and Premiums:

- Entries not registered by the midnight deadline and not included in the final paperwork picked up by the superintendent from the Fair office on 07/29/2024 will not be judged. Consequently, premiums will not be awarded.

### 4. Submission Deadline:

- All posters must be dropped off by 4 PM on July 26th, 2024, at the Pasco 4-H Extension Office.

### 5. Information Attachment to the back of the poster:

- Please use the provided link to fill in the necessary information in the Word document. Afterward, print the document, cut it down, and attach it with glue to the bottom left-hand corner of the poster. This facilitates easy identification during judging and pickup.

### 6. Lamination Recommendation:

- It is recommended (**though not mandatory**) to have posters laminated to prevent damage during handling. This is especially important as posters are often touched multiple times before being placed on displays.

**7. Glue Usage Requirement:**

- Please only use glue, preferably rubber cement, (. Rubber cement is recommended for its easy removal if there is any excess.) when putting posters together. If anything, other than glue is used, the entry will not be judged, and no premiums will be awarded.

**8. Exhibitor Responsibility:**

- Exhibitors are responsible for ensuring that their entries are registered, properly assembled, glued, and prepared according to the guidelines. Failure to comply may result in disqualification.

**9. Scoring:**

- Once an exhibit is scored, the superintendent is not authorized to change the score at any given time. The judge's evaluation and decision are final.
