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Before entering, Please refer to General Information Youth (4-H/Grange) & FFA and Rules and Regulations

1. Entries to be dropped off Sunday, Aug. 20, between 10a.m.–6p.m., building 4.
2. Each entry must have a 3" x 5" card explaining what it is, why selected to make, how it will be used, and a list of contents. Card should always include the age of the child the items were made for and care instructions.

THE SITTER

- A. Child's books with pages made of cloth

CONSUMER LIFE SKILLS - MONEY MANAGEMENT

Limit - Three entries per class. Each entry must display a different subject or topic. A chart, graph, mobile, poster (minimum size 14" x 22") or game or table display (24" x 36") showing work done in project in 4-H which enrolled. Each exhibit must have a 3" x 5" card stating project enrolled in, what principle or purpose is being taught or learned, if it is a game or educational display, and how it will be used.

- F. Any item or display made by the exhibitor in the consumer sciences project
- G. Any item or display made by the exhibitor in the money management project

SOCIAL SERVICES

LIMIT: Three entries per class provided each entry addresses a different area of the project and uses a different form to show the work (i.e., you may enter up to one graph, one poster, one mobile or any other combination that does not repeat itself, provided each shows a different area of the project). A chart, graph, mobile, poster, (minimum size 14" x 22") or game or table display (24" x 36") showing work done in project in which 4-Her is enrolled. Each exhibit must have a 3" x 5" card stating: project enrolled in, what area of the project is being presented, if it is a game or educational display and how it will be used, and target age of child item made for.
