- 2. Flowers may be brought in during static exhibit entry (Monday August 14th, from 11am 6:30pm AND at the traditional time, Tuesday, August 15th from 7:30am to 10:00am. Exhibits left outside the doors before the entry times must have a complete Fair tag with exhibitor's name and number.

You can also add this phrase to the Arrangements section, too.

- 3. Exhibitors must provide a clear container for their exhibits. Containers must be suitable for the exhibit, weighted if necessary to prevent tipping. All containers should be marked on the bottom with exhibitor's name and address.
- 4. The Fair is not responsible for containers or accessories although care will be exercised. A limited number of clear containers will be available from the superintendents to exhibitors on a first-come, first-served basis. These containers must be returned at the end of Fair.
- 5. After exhibits are in place, no one may touch or move them without permission of the superintendent, except the judge.
- 6. Exhibitors will be allowed to freshen or replace entries anytime after judging. Please check with superintendent first.
- 7. All stems should be cut at an angle and excess foliage should be removed below the water level.
- 8. Judging will be closed to the public.
- 9. Please freshen exhibits as needed.
- 10. The decision of the judge is final.


