Refer to general livestock exhibitor Rules & Regulations. Entry for all Rabbits is Monday, Aug. 14 from 2-6pm.

 All rabbits must be entered on a Livestock Stall Form. Entry forms are due to the Fair Office by Fri, July 28th, 2023.
Each exhibitor is limited to three (3) cages, any combination of single rabbit, meat pen or doe and litter. Space is limited in the Poultry/Rabbit Barn. If you do not pre-enter by filling out a livestock

request form, you will not be guaranteed a space. 3. Exhibitors must provide their own feed as well as feed and water containers. Do not leave carriers, feed buckets, or other items on top of the cages or in the barn.

4. Meat pen and doe's with litters need 2 adequate water containers and feeders.

5. Please label feed and water containers.

6. Exhibitors are expected to clean cages at the close of Fair. Rabbits must be picked up Saturday, 8/19 between 7:30-9pm, otherwise Sunday between 8am-12pm.

7. All rabbits must be out of the barn on Sunday 8/20 by 12pm Noon. All cages need to be cleaned by 12pm, or your cage deposit will be forfeited.

8. Rabbits will be health checked for ear mites, ringworm, conjunctivitis, sniffles and diarrhea. An animal showing symptoms of disease will be removed from the building immediately.

9. Toenails must be clipped before entering.

 Barn will open daily at 7:00am. Please feed and water your animal from 7-9am and 7-9pm each day. (\*Exhibitors Only)
All fur entries and Rare & Heritage Breed Entries must be entered in regular class to be eligible. Rabbits disqualified from regular classes are ineligible for participation in fur class.

12. Exhibitor responsibilities during the Fair are: Keeping area under Rabbit Cage clean, making sure your rabbit has clean water at all times, rabbit fed daily, and cleaning your rabbit's cage thoroughly at the end of fair.

13. You can help the rabbit barn run smoothly by being patient and prepared when entering rabbits, asking questions before fair time, offering to help, and keeping a smile on your face.

14. No rabbit ribbons on the front or beneath cages. Ribbons will be given at check-out for rabbit exhibitors.

15. Everyone is welcome to watch, listen and learn during judging. 16. The superintendents need runners for all classes to bring rabbits to the judging table, people to write judge's comments, and someone to punch the card with the placing. Please talk to the Barn Superintendent the day you enter your rabbit if you are interested in helping out.

17. The decision of the judge is final. Anyone interfering with will be disqualified and any awards won will be forfeited.
