- Lifeguards are here to help, but cannot take the place of a Parent or Guardian in supervising or safeguarding your child.
- Be part of our team. A parent or adult guardian (18 and older) must accompany and supervise children at all times.
- Guests must comply with lifeguards' instructions and observe posted rules at all times.
- Please report any injury to DryTown staff immediately.
- Weak or non-swimmers should wear a life jacket.
- You must wear your life jacket as it was intended to be worn.
- Only U.S. Coast Guard approved life jackets are permitted.
 Not following rules and employee instructions are grounds for removal from
- the park without a refund.

 No running, diving, rough play, splashing, smoking or foul language.
- Caution! Water is recirculated. Do not drink any water except bottled water or water from a drinking fountain
- Diapered guests must wear reusable plastic diaper covers.
- Changing diapers on or around the pool deck, on tables and chairs, or on other eating surfaces is not allowed. Diaper changing areas are provided in the restrooms.
- Anyone who has experienced a stomach and/or intestinal illness within the past two weeks should not enter any bodies of water.
