You will also play a key role in event setup and general facility maintenance. This position requires a strong work ethic, problem-solving skills, and the ability to work both independently and as part of a team. Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- Read and interpret blueprints, technical drawings, and project plans accurately.
- Perform carpentry tasks, including framing, finishing, repairs, and installations.
- Ensure precision in measuring, cutting, and assembling wood and other materials.
- Operate and maintain hand and power tools safely and effectively.
- Complete assigned tasks efficiently and in their entirety within given timeframes.
- Adapt to changing priorities and assist in other maintenance tasks, including electrical, plumbing, snow removal, and barn cleanout.
- Maintain a clean and organized work environment, following all safety protocols.
- Communicate effectively with team members and supervisors to coordinate projects.
- Follow all workplace safety guidelines and procedures to prevent accidents and injuries.

Qualifications:

- Valid driver's license and reliable transportation.
- Self-motivated with a strong work ethic and attention to detail.
- Ability to work well with others and contribute to a team environment.
- Strong knowledge of carpentry tools, equipment, and carpentry/construction techniques.
