Wisconsin Fairest of the Fairs Contestants Frequently Asked Questions for Family & Friends

The Wisconsin Association of Fairs holds their annual convention and the Wisconsin Fairest of the Fairs Contest is an event within the convention.

Q: Can my family & friends come to the contest?

A: The Wisconsin Fairest of the Fairs contest is closed to the public. There is one event each day throughout the contest that is open to the Wisconsin Association of Fairs convention attendees.

Q: Can my family & friends come to the convention?

A: Yes, your family and friends are welcome to attend the Wisconsin Association of Fair convention. Registration and the convention schedule are available on the website, <u>www.wifairs.com/convention</u>. Communicate with your local fair board for questions on convention.

Q: Can my family & friends come to the Finals Banquet and Awards on Wednesday evening?

A: Yes, your family and friends are welcome to attend the banquet and awards. The finals banquet is a separate ticketed event from convention. You can purchase tickets on the website, <u>www.wifairs.com/convention</u>. Note there is early bird pricing to save on the ticket price. Please connect with your Fair before purchasing tickets, as some Fairs may have already accounted for your family.

If your banquet tickets are purchased with your Fair, your Fair will have the tickets. If your banquet tickets are purchased separate from the fair, your tickets will need to be picked up at the Convention Registration desk prior to the banquet.

Q: Will I have time to spend with my family & friends during the contest?

A: During the contest there is no specific time to spend with family & friends. There is only time for short conversations after convention events. Cell phones are not used during the contest, so any other conversations will be at the beginning or the end of the day.

Q: Can family & friends stay in my room during the contest?

A: No, only contestants are allowed to stay in your room. You will share a room with two beds and one bathroom with another contestant.

Q: How do we make room reservations for my family & friends to stay Wednesday evening?

A: Please connect with your Fair before booking rooms, as some Fairs may have already accounted for your family. Rooms booked by December 15 are guaranteed the convention rate. You can go to www.wifairs.com/convention for the Chula Vista room options and rate.
