Late entries will be charged a fee of \$25.00 per head through July 12. After July 12th late entries will not be accepted.

Market Hogs who will not be at least 200 pounds at Tuesday weigh in should contact the Competitive Exhibits office by August 2nd to enter hog to show during the first 5 days of Fair. No late fee will be charged for switching; however, the Open Class show does have a \$12 entry fee per animal.

FFA SWINE GENERAL RULES:

- 1. Fitting, feeding and stall duty/cleaning tasks done by exhibitors only.
- 2. All swine shown in FFA must be at least 4 months old by the first day of Fair.
- 3. Limited to one animal per exhibitor in 4-H Market Hog and FFA Departments.
- 4. Animals shown in FFA are not eligible for show in 4-H.
- 5. FFA Swine may be cross entered in the Open Class Swine.
- 6. FFA members must show in fitting and showing in order to show in type and receive department premiums.
- 7. All swine must have USDA identification.

DIVISION A - FITTING AND SHOWING

All FFA exhibitors must participate in showmanship. Overall showman will compete in Round Robin Competition on Saturday. Age for showmanship determined by age as of October 1.

PREMIUMS: Blue \$27.00 Red \$22.00 White \$17.00

CLASS NUMBER

- 1. Senior: Last year high school juniors, seniors, and graduates.
- 2. Junior: Last year eighth graders and high school freshman and sophomores.
- 3. Novice: First year showing swine
