LITTLE MISS & MR FIRECRACKER RULES & INFO

Date and Time: Thursday, July 4, 2024. Check-In begins at 8:45am. Pageant will begin PROMPTLY at 10am. Please be on time. Check-in table will be located inside the Commissioners Auditorium, near the stage.

Registration Deadline: Register by 5pm Tuesday, July 2 and pay \$20 entry. Registration after July 2 will be \$25. Checks or MO to be made payable to the Makenna Elrod Seiler Foundation.

Pageant Location: Uvalde County Fairplex Commissioners Auditorium.

Two Age Divisions for both Little Miss & Little Mister: Walking through 3yrs & 4 through 6 years of age.

Competition will consist of TWO Categories: (1) Beach Wear and (2) Fourth of July Themed Outfit. Attire is at the discretion of the contestant, but should be age appropriate and in good taste at all times. Outfits should be something that the contestant feels comfortable and confident in ©.

Modeling Pattern: Contestants will have two opportunities to walk the stage for Judges; once in Beach Wear and once in a Fourth of July Themed Outfit. In each case, Contestants will enter from stage right, then immediately walk to mark on left side of stage to pose, then to mark at front of stage to pose and then mark on right side to pose and then exit off the stage where entered. Contestants may practice individually on stage during our Pre-Event Stage Practice on the day of the event from 8:45am to 9:45am.

Props, etc: Contestants may bring a prop to use on stage, but props are not required. Contestants will have access to a microphone located at the pose mark, at the front of the stage. At this mark, they may announce their first name and age, however, this is not required.

Dressing Rooms: Two separate dressing/waiting rooms will be available for use by parents and contestants for dressing, etc.

Parent/Guardian on Stage: One parent/guardian is allowed on stage to help their child in the Walking through 3 years of age Division only. For all age divisions, Parent/Guardian will be allowed to stand at entry to stage to send/receive child and to also coach and assist where needed.

Judging/Conduct: Judges will be looking at personality, stage presence and confidence. In all cases, the Judges' decisions will be final. In order to respect the integrity of the pageant, score sheets will not be given to the contestants or family members. Contestants, friends, or family members should not approach the Judges, at any time. Good conduct and sportsmanship is expected at all times during the pageant. No refunds will be given. This event is just for fun and serves as a fund-raiser for the Makenna Elrod Seiler Foundation.

Awards: Trophies will be given to <u>all</u> participants at the close of the pageant. Grand Trophies/Sashes will be presented to contestants awarded title of Little Miss & Mr. Firecracker in each age group. Trophies will also be awarded in each age group for 1st Runner-up, as well as for 2nd Runner-up. We encourage the Pageant Titleholders to wear their crowns and sashes throughout the day as they enjoy the Festival.

Admission: It is free to watch the pageant, so be sure to invite all of your friends and family members. The Pageant is the kick-off event for the 4^{th} at The Fairplex Festival – a full day of fun for the entire family, so plan to stay and play!
