General Rules

- Tractors must be parked and in the display area by 10:00 AM Monday, August 14, and are ENCOURAGED to stay the entire week. If a tractor must be moved in or out during the week, it must be done between 7am and 10am during fair week, NO EXCEPTIONS. Tractors may leave after 9:00 PM on Saturday, August 19, or on Sunday August 20.
- Tractors may ONLY be driven during specific parade times and/or transporting in and out of the fairgrounds.
- Tractors will enter/exit the fairgrounds through Gate 5 or Gate 6.
- Participation in the display or parade(s) may be revoked by the Rockingham County Fair Association for any misconduct or unsafe behavior.

Fair Parades - Monday 8/14 at 4:00PM, Wednesday 8/16 at 4PM, Thursday, 8/17 at 12PM, Saturday, August 21 at 12:00PM

- Participation in any/all parades are at the discretion of the tractor owner(s).
- On-grounds parades are Monday, Wednesday and Thursday
- Drivers under the age of 14 must have an adult with them on the tractor for the parade. Lawnmower class is open to drivers of all ages.
- Parade participants will follow the lead tractor on the prescribed route around the fairground.

Bridgewater Parade (8/19 only)

- Participation in this parade is at the discretion of the tractor owner(s).
- Drivers must have a driver's license to participate in this parade due to the travel required. Once tractors reach the destination, there is the option to add riders for the parade ONLY. Riders must get off prior to the travel back to the fairgrounds.
- Parade participants will follow the lead tractor on the prescribed route to the Bridgewater Nursing Home and White Birch Nursing Home.
- Participants for this parade must be ready to leave fairgrounds on Saturday, August 19 at 9:00AM. Estimated arrival to Bridgewater Retirement Home is 10:00AM. The estimated total event time is 2 hours.
