UNO GOLF SCRAMBLE RULES

We will be selling UNO packs of cards for \$30 for all six cards. Limit one pack of six per person. You can use them on any opponent or for yourself or your team! Below is an explanation of what the card can be used for. Once the cards are used, please place them in one of the buckets throughout the course.

- **REVERSE:** Make any opponent play with the opposite hand for one hole.
- SKIP: Make any opponent re-hit their tee off shot on one hole and they must take the worst one.
- +4: Make any opponent putt 4 balls instead of 1 at one hole (they must use the worst one).
- +2: Make any opponent take 2 shots at one hole (they must use the worst one).
- MINI WILD CARD: Makes the hole 2 putters wide at one hole.
- WILD CARD: Makes the green the hole at one hole.

Also, look up UNO Golf on YouTube, we think it will be a great addition to this fun scramble!

2-Person Golf Scramble Rules

Here's everything you need to know about how to play a 2-man scramble: What is a 2-Man Scramble? A 2man scramble is a golf tournament format in which two players team up and each hit their own ball throughout the course of the round.

However, after each shot, the team decides which ball they want to use, and then both players play their next shots from that location. This continues until the hole is completed.

Scoring in a 2-Man Scramble At the end of each hole, the team's score is recorded and compared to the scores of other teams in the tournament. The team with the lowest score on each hole receives one point.

In the case of a tie, each team receives half a point. The total number of points at the end of 9 holes determines the winner.

• All players must tee off on each hole.

• After teeing off, players must choose which ball they want to play and then both teammates must play their next shots from that spot.

• Once selected, the chosen ball cannot be switched out unless it goes out-of-bounds or into a water hazard.

- On each shot, both teammates should agree on which player will hit first.
- Players are not allowed to move obstacles (e.g., leaves, branches) in their path.
