#### SPECIAL RULES

1. **READ GENERAL RULES.** All entries and awards within this show will be subject to the General Rules and Regulations published in this Premium Book and the following Special Rules.
2. **PASSES.** Two people passes and one auto pass will be provided.
3. **LOGISTICS.** Gourd entry fee will be \$2 per gourd. Show Management shall have the right to remove from exhibition at any time, any exhibit, or part thereof which is unsightly. Stems should remain on fresh and dried gourds. Stems are optional on crafted gourds. Gourds need to be delivered directly to the Farm-A-Rama office.
4. **YOUTH BIRTH DATE.** Exhibitors must be 21 yrs. old or under as of the first of the year.
