Exhibits Check-In

- Each exhibit must be identified with an entry tag securely attached at the time of judging.
 - Entry tags will be available to exhibitors on drop off day (open & senior) and judging day (junior)
 - Arrive at the Activity Center at the scheduled time and check in with Fair staff in the lobby.
 - Refer to the <u>2025 Premium Book</u> for more information on exhibit drop off day/times

Animal Check-In

- Upon arrival at the Fair Park all animals must be checked in and be inspected by Superintendents before they may be offloaded.
- Animal Health Certificates, Premise ID, Animal Identification and Breed Association Documents may be requested at check-in, unless they were entered into FairEntry.
- Animals which do not have the correct health documentation will not be able to be unloaded and will be removed from the Fair Park.

Judging

- Sportsmanship: Stay positive and respect all Judges, Superintendents, Fair staff, Volunteers, Exhibitors and Fairgoers
- Ethics: Please keep in mind the integrity of these programs is supported by the rules and ethics policies listed in the entry information which you have agreed to follow.
- Animal welfare: It is the responsibility of each exhibitor to care for their animal exhibits in the most positive manner possible. This includes positive husbandry practices, clean housing areas, humane animal treatment, and proper animal & human safety.

This includes all exhibit decorations and supporting materials/equipment.
