Information for All Meets

1. All of our meets are invitationals. Coaches will email me to request access to the entry portal on DA.
2. All of our meets will be limited to a number of teams that allows us to keep a reasonable schedule of events and consistent level of competition.
3. The two day meets will have a higher level of competition than the one day meets.
4. We will be accepting individuals and partial teams that can compete at the competitive level of our meets.
5. Prior to the entries opening for each meet, you will receive any relevant information your institution may need for the meet, travel, and anything specific to the Indiana State Fairgrounds.
6. Please understand that if your team is accepted into our meet(s), you are submitting entry requests that will be accepted into the meet or denied based on the level of competition. This will be determined while seeding the meet. At this time, entry limits on events are not in place.
7. We will not be posting meet standards, but will allow the pool of competition dictate the standards.
8. Once you submit your entries via DA, it is the coaches' responsibility to check as to what entries were accepted or denied (by the performance list and/or meet program).
9. Entry fees will be based on accepted entries.
10. Scratches made prior to the meet are welcome, but will not change your entry fee.
11. There is no cap on entry fees.
12. Non-collegiate roster entry consideration will only be handled via email with me. Once a request for entry has been submitted (and must be done prior to the close of entries), it is the responsibility of the sender to verify if the request was accepted or denied (by the performance list and/or meet program).
13. Entries for each meet will open the second Monday prior to the meet at 8:00am. Entries will close the Tuesday prior to the meet at 2:00pm. All times used for our meets will be Eastern Standard Time.
14. Once the entries are closed and the meet is seeded, the tentative schedule of events will be adjusted to the accepted entries.
15. The final schedule of events, performance list and/or meet program, and last minute notes will be posted to our track and field page on our website [<https://www.indianastatefair.com/p/indoor-track-and-field>] in the late afternoon to early evening on the Wednesday prior to the meet.
16. Entry fees will be paid at the meet with either a credit card or check. If other arrangements need to be made for entry fees, contact me.
17. Our timing and live results will be done by PT Timing [<https://pttiming.com/>].
18. All measuring for the throws and horizontal jumps will be done with EMD.
19. All events will check-in through clerking as done for a championship meet. Officials will ex

21. The day prior to each of our meets, the facility will be open from 1:00pm to 7:00pm for shake-outs.

Information for One Day Meets

22. When we host on a Saturday, the University of Indianapolis will be hosting a Friday meet at their venue on December 6 and January 17 (20 – 30 minutes from Fall Creek Pavilion). There will be more information on this sent out later.
23. The plan is to have the option for teams competing with us to either; A decide to enter athletes at each venue on their own, or B have the ability to add athletes to the UIndy meet that are not accepted into the Saturday meet. Obviously, a team can opt to compete at both venues if accepted into both meets.
24. Entry fees for FCP one day meets will be \$35 per athlete.

Information for Two Day Meets

25. Entry fees for our two day meets is \$50 per athlete.
26. We are not planning on hosting any multi-event competitions this coming year as of now.
