- 5. All entries must be sewn by the exhibitor.
- 6. Clothing exhibits may have been worn but must be clean and pressed for judging.
- 7. Each entry must have exhibitor's name, club, and entry number securely fastened on the inside of the garment; this is not the entry tag.
