All Junior Cookers will be provided with a BBQ Pit, Charcoal, Competition Meat (2 pieces), and an Apron.

#### Rules

- 1. Entry form and payment must be received by the deadline of September 1, 2024.
- 2. Contestants must be between the ages of 8 and 14 years old.
- 3. Contestants must cook in the designated area.
- Contestants must prepare, cook, and manage the presentation of the meat unassisted.
  A BBQ Committee Volunteer will help start the fire and the child's designated adult must be supervising at all times.
- 5. Children with special needs will be allowed to do as much as they are able. The adult supervising may assist on a limited basis. *The need for special accommodations must be indicated on the registration form.*

- 6. All contestants will receive two pieces of competition meat, a grill, charcoal and an apron.
- 7. Each contestant may bring his or her own seasonings/sauces, cooking utensils (including tongs, cutting board, knives, etc.). Preparation tables are allowed and will not be furnished. Garnish is allowed in the turn in box. Garnish includes lettuce, parsley, or anything edible that fits in the turn in box.
- 8. Meat will be judged on two categories: taste and appearance of meat. Garnish is accepted but will not be judged.
- 9. Each contestant must present ten (10) pieces of meat in the turn in box. Supervising adults may assist in the cutting of the meat.
- 10. Meat portions are a blind selection. Each contestant will receive two pre-wrapped pieces of meat at the beginning of the contest.
