# Division Letter: E. Genealogy - All Ages

### Class #:

- 1. A poster, scrapbook, or display illustrating your family genealogy.
- 2. A written interview of a family member including a brief history of that person.
- 3. A poster or display featuring a photo of a deceased family member and a brief history of that person.
- 4. Any other unique method of display to tell your family story.
- 5. A poster, scrapbook, or display illustrating your family genealogy including the origin of your last name.
- 6. A written, audio or audio/video interview of a family member that tells their life story.
- 7. The story of your birth (or that of another member of your family) as told to you by at least one family member.
- 8. Any other unique method of display to tell your family story.

#### Class #:

- 1. Poster or display illustrating personal information about yourself who you are, things you like to do, your talents, favorite things
- 2. Poster or display illustrating a family chore chart.
- 3. Poster or display featuring your family and how you work together.
- 4. Poster or display illustrating a community service activity you organized or participated in.
- 5. Poster or display focused on the rights and responsibilities you and others have as good neighbors.
