- 1. Champion & Reserve Champion Awards will be given per judges' decision per department, division, or class.
- 2. Age classification is based on your age as of January 1, of the current year.
- 3. No article may be exhibited in a creative decorative class for which there is a specific listing.
- 4. Open to those enrolled in Home Environment project or Other Youth Groups doing equivalent work.

Class #:

- 1. Decorative Pillow cross stitch, needlepoint, crewel, appliquéd, patchwork, or other decorative stitching. Completed and exhibited as a pillow.
- 2. Table runner or table topper (1) or set of 4 placemats
- 3. Storage cases, containers or garbage cans (set of 2) renovated, decorated or newly constructed.
- 4. Bulletin board or message board for any room, any style, ready to hang
- 5. Table setting display (place setting for 1) no more than 7 items, at least 3 of 7 items to be created by exhibitor
- 6. Decorative item made from a kit
- 7. Any item repurposed, revised or reused with written explanation of process, may include before photos.
- 8. Quilt, any type hand quilted, tied, machine quilted, etc. (Fleece Blankets Only for Ages 8-13)
- 9. Creative wall hanging or picture, any subject, any method, any material, ready to hang (no professional framing)
- 10. Floral arrangement to set or hang no live flowers or plants
- 11. Creative accessory for the home using items from nature
- 12. Simple refinished item (plain chair, small table, small shelf, etc.) with before picture refinished including paint techniques
- 13. Recycled article for use indoor or outdoor such as chair, table, plant stand, pitchfork, wheelbarrow etc.
- 14. Turn Trash into Cash
- 15. Heritage Arts (wool rug hooking, tatting, filet crochet, hardanger, lace making, weaving, etc.)
