## JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP CONTESTS

Entry Deadline: Friday, September 1, 2023

Late Entry Deadline: September 8, 2023. No entries will be accepted at the show. Must be pre-entered.

Entry Fee: \$25 per division entered.

Check-In: Exhibitors must check-in 2 hours before their respective showmanship competition at their species show office.

## **DIVISON RULES**

- 1. **Read General Rules:** All exhibitors and participants are required to read and comply with the General Rules and Regulations, Show Ring Code of Ethics, Animal Health Regulations, and the Division Rules.
- 2. Eligibility: Only exhibitors with animals entered and showing in the Tulsa State Fair Junior Division are eligible.
- 3. **Animal:** Exhibitors must use their own animal that is properly entered in the Tulsa State Fair Junior Division when entering the showmanship contest.
- 4. **Dress Code:** All exhibitors are required wear the official Tulsa State Fair Livestock Exhibitor T-Shirt. T-Shirt will be included with your entry. Additional t-shirts can be purchased with your entry.
- 5. **Fitting:** No fitting allowed in the Heifer or Doe Showmanship Contest. Steers may be fitted, but it is not a requirement.
- 6. Age and Show Order: Contestants will be divided and shown in the following order (age as of day of show):

Junior: 8 and in the 3rd grade - 11 years old

Intermediate: 12-14 years old Senior: 15-19 years old

Pre-Junior Gilt Showmanship: 5 – 8 years old and in the 2<sup>nd</sup> grade

7. Showmanship Divisions:

Breeding Gilt Showmanship: Friday, September 29, 4 pm in the Mustang Arena. Breeding Ewe Showmanship: Friday, September 29, 6 pm in the Ranger Arena. Dairy Cattle Showmanship: Saturday, September 30, 7 pm in the Ford Truck Arena. Market Barrow Showmanship: Monday, October 2, 2 pm in the Mustang Arena. Market Lamb Showmanship: Monday, October 2, 6 pm in the Ranger Arena. Market Goat Showmanship: Monday, October 2, 5 pm in the Ranger Arena. Steer Showmanship: Monday, October 2, 5 pm in the Ford Truck Arena. Breeding Doe Showmanship: Thursday, October 5, 4 pm in the Ranger Arena. Breeding Heifer Showmanship: Friday, October 6, 2 pm in the Ford Truck Arena.

- 8. **Premiums & Awards:** Premiums will be awarded in class in the Junior, Intermediate and Senior Divisions. No premiums will be paid out to the Pre-Junior Gilt Showmanship, just awards. Rosettes awarded to the Champion and Reserve Champion Showman in each age group per specie. Banner, Buckle, and Richard Gebhart Scholarship Award will be presented to the Overall Champion and Reserve Overall Champion in each specie division.
- 9. **Richard Gebhart Scholarship Award:** The Overall Champion in each division will receive a tuition waiver to Rogers State University. Scholarship award must be redeemed by attending Rogers State University. Not a cash exchange.
