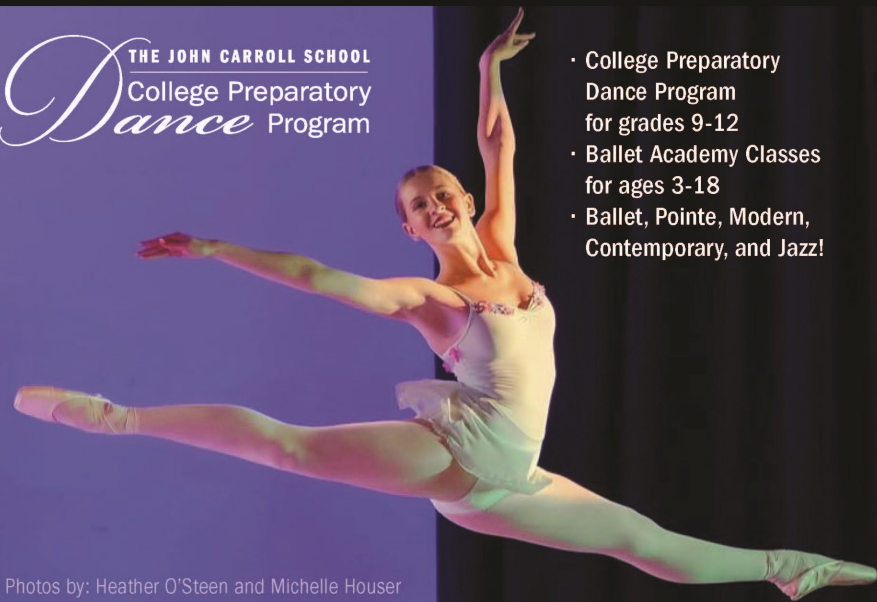

Welcome!

We are back for another installation of the Kinetic Canvas Series! I have officially made it to my eighth production as Artistic Director of the Kinetic Canvas Series; what a ride it has been! I can say with confidence that the show you are about to see will continue to defy your expectations of what you expect to see from community dance theatre in Harford County, MD.

My job as the artistic director of Kinetic Canvas is to choose an artist, research them, and craft a production that's inspired by the artist and their art. Each show is uniquely created to showcase what about the art or artist spoke to me. This year I've pulled the inspiration for the production from Da Vinci's art, research, and writing. I dove deep into Da Vinci's journals to find passages and research that spoke to me. As arguably the most famous painter in the world, his artwork was an easy source of inspiration and selecting six of his works was an effortless task. However, I struggled with how I would take on the daunting task of presenting "The Renaissance Man" with the grandeur he deserves.

During my research I kept coming back to the same thought and idea over and over. When we think about Da Vinci, we are immediately drawn to how old his work is and how it feels like such a foreign time. However, this man and his research, techniques, inventions, and innovations were ground-breaking! And that's where I found it... the true inspiration and over-arching theme for the show. Kinetic Canvas: Leonardo da Vinci celebrates the simultaneous marriage and juxtaposition of how everything surrounding Leonardo da Vinci is both old and brand new. Throughout the show, you will find nods to renaissance fashion and design, classical dance vocabulary, classical music, and other elements that feel dated; combined with modern technology, current contemporary dance vocabulary and styling, and music that the renaissance era could never comprehend.

With this idea of old and new in mind, and the fact that I have the most talented cast of Kinetic Canvas history to date, I decided it was time to try something. As always, I took on the role of lead choreographer within the production and invited back Maggie DeFrees and Kamea Wilson, long-time contributors to the Kinetic Canvas Series, to the choreography team to represent the old. For the new, I implemented a new program within the series as an opportunity for our cast members to take on leadership and creative positions as choreographic collaborators. Those who auditioned for this new program were assigned a partner or partners and a topic of Da Vinci's research to create a short "dancette" about. I am absolutely thrilled with what our collaborators created and the over-all success of the program!

My wish is that as you watch this production, you will be an engaged audience member and participate in the beauty that's live theater. If you like what you see, let the dancers know! I can promise that your energy fuels the performance. Let's make some magic tonight!

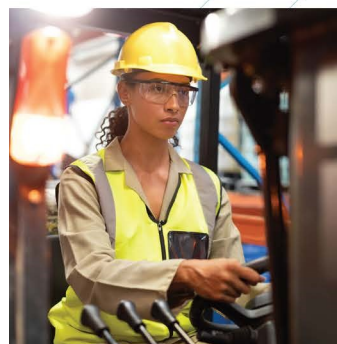
